Nethack Quick Reference

Basic Movement

7 8 9 Use the NumPad to move your character in one of the 8 directions. Hold Shift to move until you hit something interesting.

j jump to another location

< > go up to the previous level, next level

#chat talk to a character

#sit sit down

: rest for one turn

n rest for n turns

Advanced Movement

mNumPad move without picking up or fighting

FNumPad fight a monster (if you guess one is there)

MNumPad move far, no pickup

gNumPad move until something interesting is found

GNumPad move as g, but corridor forks uninteresting

Inventory

i inventory

) what weapon you are wielding

[..... what armor you are wearing

= what rings you are wearing

“ what amulet you are wearing

(..... tools you are using

* What equipment (combines prev 5 commands)

\$ count your zorkmids (gold pieces)

I list parts of your inventory

I* list all gems in your inventory

Iu list all used up items in your inventory

Ix purchase unpaid items in your inventory

p purchase unpaid items in your inventory

Exploration

; look – use NumPad to position, . to select

: look where you are standing

s ns search for secret doors and traps, search n times

o c open door, close door

k kick something (usually a door)

#force force lock (usually chests, doors)

l loot something (usually chest or box)

u un-trap something (trap, door, chest)

Personal Needs

e eat food or nearby corpse

#monster use your special ability (when polymorphed)

#wipe wipe off your face

#pray pray to the gods for help

q toggle auto-pickup (good for stores)

a apply (generic use command)

z Zap a wand (use . for direction to zap self)

q quaff (drink) a potion

#dip dip an object into something

#rub rub a lamp

#offer offer a sacrifice to the gods

d drop something

dna drop n items of object a

D drop several things

Da drop all without asking

Di examine inventory before dropping

Du drop all unpaid items

Dm use a menu to select what to drop

D%u drop only unpaid food

r read something (usually scroll, spell book)

#ride ride or stop riding a monster (usually pet pony)

P put on a ring or other accessory (amulet, blindfold)

R remove one or more accessories (armor, rings)

Attacking

NumPad towards a monster to fight melee

t throw an object or shoot a projectile

f fire an object from your quiver

Q put objects (usually arrows or bolts) in your quiver

w wield a weapon

w- wield nothing, ie bare hands

x swap wielded weapon with secondary weapon

W wear armor

T take off armor

#twoWeapon toggle two-weapon combat (if suitable)

#enhance advance or check weapons skills

Magic

r read something (usually scroll, spell book)

q quaff (drink) a potion

z Zap a wand (use . for direction to zap self)


Z zap (cast) a spell

+ list of spells you know

#invoke invoke an object's special powers

a apply a wand to snap it in two (catastrophic)

Ctrl-t Teleport (if you have ability)



N name an item, or type of object

C call (name) an individual monster

E engrave a message on the floor

E- write in the dust with your finger

Miscellaneous

? help menu

/ explain what a symbol means

/; explains the symbol with more info? Option /;

/; explain the symbol without more info

/; explain without more info, stop asking further

/; explain with more info without asking

\ information about a trap next to you

\ a list of everything you have identified/discovered

#conduct list of challenges you have adhered to

#? List of extended commands

Ctrl-l-p repeat previous message (repeatable)

Ctrl-x display info about your char, alignment, deities &.... tell what a command does

Other Useful Commands

S save and quit – use your chars name to restore

#quit quit without saving

Ctrl-A Redo previous command

Ctrl-r redraw the screen

v display version number of Nethack

V display history of Nethack

X eXplore / Wizard mode – check guidebook

#adjust adjust letters in your inventory

#version display compile-time options for this build

! escape to a shell prompt (usually Unix only)

Ctrl-z suspend the game (Unix with job control only)
